Submission Guidelines

DEADLINE: March 1, 2022

Theme: “Generation Rescue: Sustainable Water for All”

Students should explore the following questions:

1. What does water sustainability mean to you?
2. Has your community been affected by climate change and water disruption?
3. How can you, as a future leader, contribute to the solution?

Medium & Specifications:

- Digital mediums will be accepted in this category. Digital art refers to art made using software, computers, or other electronic devices.
- **Moving art pieces will not be accepted** – only still frame submissions are permitted.
- Please ensure that submissions have a minimum of a 1350x1080 pixels and are saved in a .jpeg or .png file type.
- Judges will evaluate submissions based on theme interpretation, and creativity.
- All work must be original.

Entries:

- Each participating student artist must be between 13 and 18 years of age by April 1, 2022. All entries must be the original design and artwork of the entrant. Only new pieces inspired by the theme should be submitted. When describing their artwork in the application form, students are encouraged to discuss how their local communities and/or international cities are approaching this year's theme. Students can talk about collaborative efforts between communities, give project examples, or explore areas of potential cooperation within the water sustainability field.

Awards:

International Competition: First, Second, and Third place winners will be selected in the international competition in Washington D.C. The Grand Prize Winner (1st place) will receive \$1,000; 2nd place will receive \$250; and 3rd place will receive \$100. The winning art pieces will be published on the Sister Cities International website.
